A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING THE SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET FOR PROJECT NO. 10140, FUND 405, FOR REPAIRS, UPGRADES, AND AN ADDITION TO STATION 61.

WHEREAS, Station 61 was built in 2000-2001, and after 18 years of continued population growth and changes in operations such as full time Emergency Services and fire units, the facility is now at a critical point of needing upgrades; and

WHEREAS, additionally, the November 2018 earthquake damaged suspended ceiling assemblies on both floors and caused multiple aesthetic cracks and gaps throughout the building that require remediation; and

WHEREAS, this station was scheduled for an addition and upgrades within the next two to three years; and

WHEREAS, the timeline needs to be expedited due to the earthquake damage and operational needs of the department; and

WHEREAS, the Central Mat-Su Fire Service Area Board of Supervisors has approved a fund balance appropriation of \$4,000,000 to a project for repairs, upgrades, and an addition to Station 61; and

WHEREAS, funding for this project is specified in the scope of work and budget contained herein; and

WHEREAS, the above funds were appropriated to project no. 10140, by Ordinance Serial No. 19-053.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly hereby approves the scope of work and budget for project no. 10140, fund 405, for the repairs, upgrades, and addition to Station 61.

#### SCOPE OF WORK

Design, permitting, construction, furnishings and equipment, and all components to facilitate repairs and a functional upgrade and addition to Station 61.
