SUMMARY STATEMENT: The Police Powers Task Force was created through Ordinance Serial No. 19-030, in order to fulfill the voters request to explore the possibility of adding police powers to the Borough's responsibilities, and to put the proposal to the voters on the next regular ballot. The initial date for presenting to the Assembly was June 29, 2019, and the original sunset date was December 31, 2019. The Task Force members advised that these dates do not allow sufficient time for this task and have requested an extension to the subject dates.

RECOMMENDATION OF ADMINISTRATION: Approval of the Police Powers Task Force's request for the Assembly to extend the date the recommendations are due to the Assembly to December 31, 2019 and extend the sunset date to May 1, 2020.
