SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The City of Wasilla's Dispatch Center has requested funding assistance from the Enhanced 911 Advisory Board.

The City of Wasilla's Dispatch Center intends to improve their Call Taker's ability to visualize call details and provide an immediate and separate control of the E-911 system by providing call takers with new monitors, control pads, and keyboard equipment.

The City of Wasilla's Dispatch Center would like to convert their training requirements from using the live E-911 system to that of a scenario based training on a stand-alone system and the stand-alone training system would be available to, and benefit, both the City of Wasilla and the City of Palmer dispatch centers.

The City of Wasilla intends to build a backup PSAP center in its new police department building. Until such time as the new police department is built, being able to purchase this equipment now and put it into the existing building will enable the City to provide a backup location to its dispatch center in a more timely fashion.

On January 8, 2019, the Enhanced 911 Advisory Board approved three appropriations all totaling \$154,736 from the Enhanced 911 Fund Balance to the City of Wasilla as follows; \$15,884 - E-911 Equipment; \$33,166 - E-911 Training Simulator; \$105,686 - Backup PSAP.

RECOMMENDATION OF ADMINISTRATION:

The administration recommends approval of the attached legislation, which will approve an appropriation of \$154,736 from the Enhanced 911 Fund Balance, Fund 202, and approve the scopes of work and budgets for Project 45283, Fund 480, to allow the City of Wasilla to obtain reimbursement from Enhanced 911 surcharge funding for E-911 equipment, software, and professional services and training.
