SUMMARY STATEMENT:

Before you is a resolution of the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly to establish the manner in which closed School Bond Capital Project Funds should be expended. Currently there are several projects in the process of being closed out with DEED. Once these projects are complete and project termination agreements have been executed, the cumulative amount of excess funds is calculated to be approximately \$9.2 million dollars. Typically, these funds would be redirected to other school projects in accordance with State of Alaska 4 ACC 31.064. In light of the current budget climate, it is prudent to put these funds towards future Debt Service payments.

Recommendation of Administration: Administration recommends adoption of resolution 19-061 to transfer excess School Capital Project Funds to the School Facilities Debt Service Fund to pay for future Debt Service.
