SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The purchase and installation of new modern radio communication equipment in the apparatus will ensure better emergency communications and that radios are in FCC compliance for the future. The purchase and installation of GPS activated Opticom emitters will provide the ability to activate traffic control signals during a response so emergency apparatus can navigate intersections safely and continue the flow of traffic at these intersections.

Our current Personal Protective Equipment is either facing a 10 year life cycle or, due to emergency responses and training, is showing signs of wear to the materials that cannot be repaired. This project will be used to purchase coats, pants, boots and

helmets for responders to wear during emergency response activities to ensure firefighter safety while performing fire suppression activities.

Currently station 3-2 has a 300 gallon fuel tank for the heating system which is too small and needs to be filled on a short rotation and purchasing a 500 gallon fuel oil tank for heating Station 32 will allow for extended times between resupplies. As there is always the possibility of a mishap where the fuel delivery could be delayed, a larger fuel tank can make up the time needed until the scheduled delivery can be performed.

The Greater Palmer Consolidated Fire Service Area Board of Supervisors has approved moving a combined total of \$70,000 from the Greater Palmer Consolidated Fire Service Area Fund Balance to purchase communications and GPS equipment, personal protective equipment, and provide funding for a fuel oil tank project for Station 3-2.
