SUMMARY STATEMENT:

This resolution is coming forward as a follow-up and alternative to efforts made in the last year to form a working group, dedicated to the development of recommendations for commercial, educational and nonprofit outdoor shooting facilities (shooting facilities). This group was intended to consider input from the public, do volunteer research on aspects of shooting facility ordinance, and make recommendations to the Assembly and administration on any issue related to the regulation of such facilities. Due to a lack of applicants, this working group was never formed and the enabling ordinance for the group sunset August 7, 2019. The details of this effort were presented to the Assembly on August 6, 2019 in IM 19-137.

This resolution directs staff to do the same types of research proposed for the working group, to gather input from the public, and to use this information to develop a conditional use permit process for shooting facilities subject to review by the Planning Commission and adoption by the Assembly.

RECOMMENDATION OF ADMINISTRATION:

Staff respectfully recommends adoption of resolution 19-083.
