A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING THE SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE HUMAN SERVICES COMMUNITY MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Alaska State Department of Health and Social Services has awarded a Human Services Community Matching Grant in the amount of \$294,374 to the Borough; and

WHEREAS, these grant funds to be allocated for essential health services and treatment programs were accepted and appropriated by the Assembly by Ordinance Serial No. 19-115; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly wishes to support the efforts of nonprofit organizations that provide high-quality, cost efficient, and community-driven health and human services; and

WHEREAS, it is understood that the Borough and the Alaska State Department of Health and Social Services will have access to all participants' grant records and authority to monitor all activities;

WHEREAS, the State requires a 30 percent cash match, equaling \$126,160, for this grant program; and

WHEREAS, in the fiscal year 2019 capital project budget the Assembly appropriated \$150,000 in Areawide funds for human services grant match; and

WHEREAS, it is our intention to use \$126,160 of these funds to meet the required match for this grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly hereby approves the scope of work and budget for the Borough's participation in the Human Services Community Matching Grant Program.

SCOPE OF WORK


To provide funds for essential health services and treatment programs to non-profit organizations within the Matanuska-Susitna Borough.


