I MOVE to amend Resolution 19-100, which was previously adopted on December 27, 2019, by inserting the following project under Borough Funding Priorities:

G. Shirley Towne Drive Bridge - \$3.2 Million

The Shirley Towne Drive Bridge incurred severe damage and the road approach at the north end of the bridge was washed out by flooding in 2012. No bridge replacement or repairs has occurred to-date leaving Deneki Bridge, which is several miles downstream, as the sole means of access. The road access to the Deneki Bridge is within the Willow Creek floodplain and periodically floods throughout the year including winter due to ice-jams. It is imperative to have a second means of access for residents and users of the land on the north side of Willow Creek during natural disasters such as flooding, fire or earthquakes. The replacement or repair of Shirley Towne Drive Bridge would provide this second means of access to North Willer Kash Road and North Jim Carter Road, which are access points for Borough and State timber harvest areas. Funding for this project would provide for design, right-of-way acquisition, utility relocation and construction.
