MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 20-001

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING 2018 COOK INLET EARTHQUAKE DISASTER RELIEF MONIES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,050,943.70 FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) AND \$350,314.56 FROM THE ALASKA STATE DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT (DHS&EM), TO FUND 445, PROJECT NOS. 55026 AND 55027.

WHEREAS, On November 30, 2018, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough sustained severe damages to Borough roads, schools, public facilities and infrastructure due to a magnitude 7.0 earthquake; and

WHEREAS, a local, state and federal disaster declaration was issued; and

WHEREAS, costs incurred during the disaster were determined to be eligible for state (25%) and federal (75%) funding assistance; and

WHEREAS, projects have been identified and funds obligated for a portion of the 2018 Cook Inlet Earthquake; and

WHEREAS, additional legislation will be brought forward until all eligible projects have been awarded.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and appropriation source. The Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly does hereby authorize the acceptance and appropriation of the 2018 Cook Inlet Earthquake disaster relief monies to fund 445, in the amount of \$510,456.26 for project No. 55026 (School District) and \$890,802.00 for project No. 55027 (Borough Infrastructure) from the Federal Emergency Management Agency and the Alaska State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management.

Section 4. <u>Effective date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly.
