A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING
THE SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET FOR A PORTION OF THE 2018 COOK INLET
EARTHQUAKE DISASTER RELIEF MONIES, PROJECT NOS. 55026 AND 55027.

WHEREAS, On November 30, 2018, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough sustained severe damages to Borough roads, schools, public facilities and infrastructure due to a magnitude 7.0 earthquake; and

WHEREAS, a local, state and federal disaster declaration was issued; and

WHEREAS, costs incurred during the disaster were determined to be eligible for state (25%) and federal (75%) funding assistance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby approves the following scope of work and budget for a portion of the 2018 Cook Inlet Earthquake disaster relief monies, project Nos. 55026 and 55027, fund 445.

SCOPE OF WORK

Emergency protective measures, emergency response, debris removal, replacement and/or repair of borough schools, roads, bridges, facilities, and infrastructure from damage caused by the 2018 Cook Inlet Earthquake disaster.
