SUMMARY STATEMENT: On November 30, 2018 the Matanuska-Susitna Borough sustained damage to infrastructure due to a magnitude 7.0 earthquake. A borough, state and federal disaster declaration was issued for November 30, 2018. Allowed costs are eligible for 75% federal and 25% state funding assistance.

As a result of the earthquake, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough sustained severe damages to borough roads, bridges, schools, public facilities and infrastructure. Since the event, employees from the borough, state (DHS&EM), federal (FEMA), and school district have been working to gather information, identify damages, conduct inspections, and formulate projects so grant funds can be awarded. To date a total of 99 eligible damages have been identified resulting in 29 projects formulated. Award

documents will be issued by project, after project worksheets (PW) are generated, until all eligible projects have been obligated. This legislation, if approved, will accept and appropriate the following projects that have been obligated by FEMA and are pending award.

Project 55026 (School District)

- PW114 MSBSD Emergency Protective Measures \$ 510,456.26

Project 55027 (Borough Infrastructure)

- PW74 Point MacKenzie Area Roads \$ 890,802.00

Total for both Projects \$1,401,258.26

As the remaining projects are awarded, additional legislation will be brought forward. The total award amount for all projects from the 2018 Cook Inlet Earthquake has not yet been determined. To date legislation has been approved or is pending approval as shown below:
