SUMMARY STATEMENT: The Matanuska-Susitna Borough has been the fastest growing borough in the State this past decade. Priorities and action from the State of Alaska have not recognized the great potential of the Matanuska-Susitna Borough's impact on the State's economy nor the needs of its people.

The following are the priorities for State action and funding for fiscal year 2021 as presented to the Assembly for consideration.

Borough Action Priorities:

- Full Complement of Trooper Staffing and Presence in the Mat-Su Valley equaling 71 sworn officers.
- Representation from Mat-Su Valley on State Commissions, and Directorial Positions.
- · Action on State's West Susitna Roads to Resources Program.
- Support for Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities Office at Seward-Meridian Parkway.

- Support for Alaska Department of Fish and Game Office in the Mat-Su Borough.
- Support for U.S. Marine Corps Training Site at Port MacKenzie.
- State-Wide Transportation Bonds.

Borough Funding Priorities:

- Matching Funds for Voter Approved Road Bond Projects \$23.845 Million
- Bogard Road and Engstrom Road/Green Forest Drive Intersection Upgrade \$7.6 Million
- Completion of Port MacKenzie Rail Extension \$130 Million
- Port MacKenzie Deep-Draft Dock Pile Sleeve Protection \$6 Million
