

January 29: Assessment notices mailed, Values posted to the web, 30 day appeal period commences


February 28: Appeal period ends


April: Appeal hearings begin

June 1: Assessment roll certified



2020 Property Tax Base by Value






New Construction By Value

Additional Projects

- ▶ 2019 was very busy working with the disasters including an earthquake, several wild fires and flooding. The interminable 2018 cyber-incident continues to create additional work as we are still rebuilding reports and tools including the ones needed to generate this annual report.
- GIS worked to develop interactive electronic mapping for use with our IPad, and a collector app that is used in conjunction with our land modeling project.
- ▶ We have resumed our mobile project, this was halted during the cyber incident. We anticipate being mobile by spring of 2020.
- ▶ We are making progress with our updated CAMA system, Govern OpenForms. This upgrade will replace a 20+ year old system that is inefficient. We anticipate going live in the summer of 2020.
- ► We implemented a systematic auditing process for exemptions / that identified approximately 280 applications to be reviewed for compliance. This review is still in progress.
