**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 20-007**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING AN APPROPRIATION OF 60,000 FROM THE GREATER PALMER CONSOLIDATED FIRE SERVICE AREA FUND BALANCE, FUND 259, TO PROJECT NOS. 45155 AND 10166, FUND 405, TO ALLOW THE GREATER PALMER CONSOLIDATED FIRE SERVICE AREA TO EXPAND AND PAVE THE PARKING LOT AND DRIVEWAY AT STATION 3-2 AND REPLACE THE BAY DOORS AT STATION 3-5.

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WHEREAS, the Station 3-2 building was expanded, using a portion of the existing driveway and parking area; and

WHEREAS, to recreate an efficient driveway and adequate parking space, an expansion of these areas is necessary; and

WHEREAS, the apparatus bay doors at Station 3-5 are made of heavy wood and are past due for replacement; and

WHEREAS, replacement doors that are lighter and more energy efficient will improve the building and its function; and

WHEREAS, the Greater Palmer Consolidated Fire Service Area Board of Supervisors has approved moving a total of \$60,000 from the Greater Palmer Consolidated Fire Service Area fund balance to expand the parking lot at Station 3-2 and replace the bay doors at Station 3-5; and

WHEREAS, the scopes of work and budgets are contained in Resolution Serial No. 20-005.


BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.


Section 2. Appropriation Source. The Assembly hereby approves appropriations of \$40,000 to project no. 45155; and \$20,000 to project no. 10166, fund 405, from the Greater Palmer Consolidated Fire Service Area fund balance, fund 259, to expand and pave the parking lot and driveway at Station 3-2 and replace the bay doors at Station 3-5.

Section. 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
