SUMMARY STATEMENT: The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to establish a three-year partnership (2020-2023) between the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) and the Matanuska-Susitna Borough (MSB) that will enhance cooperation between the two entities and optimize the way transportation and land use is planned, funded and developed in the fastest growing region of Alaska.
