WHEREAS, a cultural resources survey is necessary to ensure trail construction does not negatively affect cultural resources; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance Serial No. 20-017 accepted and appropriated \$15,474 from the National Park Service passed through Alaska Department of Natural Resources for the Settlers Bay Coastal Park cultural resources survey, project no. 15040, fund 440; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires the Borough to provide a match of \$9,508; and

WHEREAS, the Borough will provide \$9,508 from the Fiscal Year 2019 Areawide capital appropriation for the Community Transportation Block Grant match, which was not awarded to the

Borough.
