SUMMARY STATEMENT: The Borough received notice of a grant award from the Federal Highway Administration passed through the Alaska State Department of Natural Resources in the amount of \$61,180 to improve the Eska Strip Mine Trail from the end of Jonesville Mine Road to the Eska Creek Falls Trailhead.

The grant funds will be used to import and spread gravel, and pay a contractor to operate a linear crusher along the trail.

The grant requires the Borough to provide a match of 6,798. The match will be provided by the Land and Resources Management FY20 and FY21 operating budgets and the Recreation Services FY20 and

FY21 operating budgets as in-kind donations of labor and equipment.
