## MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 20-040

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROPRIATING UP TO \$130,000 FROM THE COMMUNITY TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM GRANT MATCH BUDGET TO PROVIDE THE REQUIRED LOCAL MATCH FOR FEDERAL TRANSIT GRANT FOR SUNSHINE TRANSIT TO PURCHASE AND MODIFY A TRANSIT FACILITY.

WHEREAS, Sunshine Transit is seeking to purchase and remodel a transit facility; and

WHEREAS, Sunshine Transit is eligible for Federal Transportation Administration grant funds that require a local match of up to \$130,000 to receive the funding granted by the Alaska Community Transit Office; and

WHEREAS, Sunshine Transit provides a necessary service for the residents of Talkeetna, Willow, and Houston who are otherwise unable to drive; and

WHEREAS, Sunshine Transit provides access to basic goods and services, including grocery and laundry trips; and

WHEREAS, Mat-Su Transit providers are also providing delivery services to our most at risk citizens during the COVID-19 pandemic lockdown.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Appropriation Source. The Assembly appropriates \$130,000 from the Community Transportation Program Grant Match budget to provide the required 20 percent local match for federal transit grants to purchase and modify a transit facility for Sunshine Transit. Community Transportation Program Grant Match; Capital Projects/Grants; Matanuska-Susitna Borough Approved Annual Budget fiscal year 2019.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
