MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO.20-041

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$28,800 IN FEDERAL FUNDS FROM THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION THROUGH THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR THE SETTLERS BAY COASTAL PARK PROJECT NO. 15040 FUND 440, TO DEVELOP AND PRODUCE INTERPRETIVE SIGNAGE AT THE PARK; REAPPROPRIATE \$3,200 FROM AREAWIDE FUNDS, PROJECT NO. 99999 GRANT MATCH, FUND 480 TO FUND 440, TO SATISFY THE REQUIRED MATCH.

WHEREAS, the Borough received property known as the Settlers Bay Coastal Park abutting Knik Arm in the Settlers Bay and Secluded Point subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly adopted the Settlers Bay Coastal Park Recreation Development Plan in June of 2018; and

WHEREAS, wheelchair accessible trails are planned along the bluff above Knik Arm, which is the most scenic and culturally rich area in the park; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration awarded federal grant funds through the Alaska State Department of Natural Resources in the amount of \$28,800 for development of an interpretive plan and panels for the Settlers Bay Coastal Park as part of the Alaska Recreational Trails Program; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires the Borough to provide a match of \$3,200; and

WHEREAS, the Borough will provide the \$3,200 cash match from the fiscal year 2019 areawide capital appropriation for the community transportation block grant match, which was not awarded to the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds will be used to develop an interpretive plan and produce three interpretive panels for the park.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance. The Assembly hereby accepts \$28,800 from the Alaska Recreational Trails Program for the development of an interpretive plan and production of three interpretive panels for the Settlers Bay Coastal Park.

Section 3. Appropriation Source. There is hereby appropriated by the Assembly \$28,800 from the Federal Highway Administration passed through the Alaska State Department of Natural Resources, to project no. 15040, fund 440, for Settlers Bay Coastal Park Interpretive Plan and panels.

Section 4. Re-appropriation. The Assembly hereby reappropriates \$3,200 from project 99999, community no.

transportation block grant match, fund 480, to the Settlers Bay Coastal Park, project no. 15040, fund 440.

Section 5. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
