ORDINANCE SERIAL NO.20-048**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$61,180 IN FEDERAL FUNDS FROM THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION THROUGH THE ALASKA STATE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR THE ESKA STRIP MINE TRAIL PROJECT, PROJECT NO. 15015, FUND 440, TO IMPROVE THE ESKA STRIP MINE TRAIL.

WHEREAS, in 2005, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough entered into a management agreement with the Alaska State Department of Natural Resources for the management of the Eska Creek Falls Hiking Trail that is accessed from the end of the Eska Strip Mine Trail; and

WHEREAS, the Eska Strip Mine Trail needs significant maintenance to improve access; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration awarded federal grant funds through the Alaska State Department of Natural Resources in the amount of \$61,180 for improvement of the Eska Strip Mine Trail as part of the Alaska Recreational Trails Program; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires the Borough to provide a match of \$6,798; and

WHEREAS, the match will be provided by the Land and Resources Management fiscal year 2020 and fiscal year 2021 operating budgets and the Recreation Services fiscal year 2020 and fiscal year 21 operating budgets as in-kind donations of labor and equipment.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance. The Assembly hereby accepts \$61,180 from the Alaska Recreational Trails Program for the improvement of the Eska Strip Mine Trail.

Section 3. Appropriation Source. There is hereby appropriated by the Assembly \$61,180 from the Federal Highway Administration passed through the Alaska State Department of Natural Resources, to project no. 15015, fund 440, for the Eska Strip Mine Trail Project.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
