A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING THE SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET FOR THE ESKA STRIP MINE TRAIL PROJECT, PROJECT NO. 15015, FUND 440.

WHEREAS, in 2005, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough entered into a management agreement for the management of the Eska Creek Falls Hiking Trail which is accessed from the end of the Eska Strip Mine Trail; and

WHEREAS, both the Eska Creek Falls Trail and the Eska Strip Mine Trail are established trails in the Jonesville Public Use Area; and

WHEREAS, the Borough is working with the Sutton Community and the State to develop a Jonesville Public Use Area Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance Serial No. 20-048, accepted and appropriated \$61,180 from the Federal Highway Administration passed through the Alaska State Department of Natural Resources to improve the Eska Strip Mine Trail, project no.15015, Fund 440; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires the Borough to provide a match of \$6,798; and

WHEREAS, the match will be provided by the Land and Resources Management fiscal year 2020 and fiscal year 2021 operating budgets

and Recreation Services fiscal year 2020 and fiscal year 2021 operating budgets as in-kind donations of labor and equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby approves the following scope of work and budget for the Eska Strip Mine Trail Project.

#### **SCOPE OF WORK**

Improve the Eska Strip Mine Trail using imported earth materials and heavy equipment.
