HISTORIC PRESERVATION PLAN - PHASE II (20203) \$22,299

The borough Historic Preservation plan needs updating. Phase I of this update was funded by a Historic Preservation Grant and will be completed by the end of 2020. Once Phase I is completed Phase II, Drafting of the updated plan, will begin. Funding will be used to hire a contractor that meeting the federal requirements for preparing a historic preservation plan. Staff will then work with the contractor and the Borough Historic Preservation Commission to complete Phase II - drafting the Historic Preservation Plan.

Extend expiration date of project account to June 30, 2023.

STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN (47514) \$50,000

Staff will work with a contractor to develop the planning documents necessary to meet the federal requirements; in addition funding

will be used for MS4 specific training for borough staff and for Storm Water Management specific outreach.

Extend expiration date of project account to June 30, 2023.

BOROUGH WIDE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UPDATE (47520) \$90,000

the Borough continues to grow, an updated Borough-wide comprehensive plan is needed. The currently adopted Borough-wide Comprehensive Development Plan, last updated in 2005; originally adopted in 1970 contains sections addressing Boroughwide, as well as, community based plans, specific plans such as the Long Range Transportation Plan and Lake Management Plans, and plans prepared by the State of Alaska, such as the Susitna Area Plan. The purpose of revising the Borough-wide Comprehensive Plan of 1970, as amended (2005), is to update the section addressing Borough-wide growth and development issues. In addition, this revision will discuss the method of comprehensive planning used by the Borough, how community based plans and Borough-wide plans relate to one another, and Borough-wide planning issues. Borough-wide Comprehensive Plan, as amended (2005), provides general goals and policy recommendations to help guide future development in order to enhance our quality of life and the public health, safety, and welfare. These funds will be used for staff to work with a contractor on a comprehensive update to the 2005 Comprehensive Plan; "Mat-Su Vision 2040." It will also provide a means of public outreach and hosting open houses.

Extend expiration date of project account to June 30, 2023.

The accounts below, along with those above, are being extended to June 30, 2023 to allow time for project completion.

CENSUS 2020 (45002)

Funding will be used to purchase software and hire contractors associated with State redistricting and Assembly reapportionment following the release of 2020 Census data.

Extend expiration date of project account to June 30, 2023.

BOARD OF FISHERIES PROPOSALS (47021)

Funding will be used to support the Fish and Wildlife Commission's work, including, but not limited to meeting support at the Board of Fisheries, publications, printing, research, training, site tours, presentations, outreach efforts, consulting/contractors, and other expenses for Matanuska-Susitna Borough Fish and Wildlife Commission members and staff.

Extend expiration date of project account to June 30, 2023.

PUBLIC OUTREACH, EDUCATION & INCENTIVES (47052-4201)

As the borough grows, so does the cost of public outreach. This funding will be used to provide public outreach and work with a

contractor on developing a borough wide internal and external communications plan to be used for all planning efforts.

Extend expiration date of project account to June 30, 2023.

PUBLIC OUTREACH, EDUCATION & INCENTIVES (47052-4202)

The State of Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) is giving the Matanuska-Susitna Borough two air quality monitors; one that reads PM2.5 and the other reads PM10. The monitors will require a data subscription and collaborating yearly. These funds will pay for the subscription and collaborating expenses as well as public outreach for air quality, code and manual rewrites and planning effort. Additionally, it will be used as match funding for air quality improvement grants and incentive campaigns.

REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLANNING (47038)

This funding will be utilized to conduct regional transportation planning efforts, to fund continuing education opportunities, public involvement, and implement recommendations from adopted transportation related plans.

Extend expiration date of project account to June 30, 2023.

RECOMMENDATION OF ADMINISTRATION: Staff respectfully requests Assembly adoption of the legislation reappropriating \$22,299 from fund 475, project account 20392 to to fund 440, project 20203 Historic Preservation Plan - Phase II; and \$50,557 from project accounts 20392, 20393, and 20397 fund 475; to fund 480, projects 47520, Borough Wide Comprehensive Plan and Stormwater Management Plan, and moving \$49,073 from project Housing Analysis, and \$40,370 from 45177 project Transportation ROW Corridor Project, fund 480 to project 47520 Borough Wide Comprehensive Plan Update, and; resolution approving the scopes of work and budgets for project nos. 20203 Historic Preservation Plan - Phase II, 47021 Board of Fisheries, 47052 Public Outreach, Education & Incentives.
