A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY SETTING THE SCOPE OF WORK AND AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR PROJECT 10151, FUND 435, TO IMPROVE THE ANIMAL CARE FACILITY BY ADDING AN OUTSIDE COVERED DOG WALK AND REMEDIATING THE BLACK MOLD DISCOVERED IN THE AREA OF THE DOG KENNELS.

WHEREAS, the Assembly accepted and appropriated donation funds in fiscal year 2011 for project 10151, fund 435, for supplies and care of rescued dogs of which \$13,765.73 is still available; and

WHEREAS, A portion of the fiscal year 2020 Animal Care and Regulation public donations in the amount of \$10,127.91 will be appropriated to Project 10151, Fund 435; and

WHEREAS, \$25,000 will be reappropriated from fiscal year 2020 Animal Care and Regulation operating budget, fund 200, into project no. 10151, fund 435, for supplies and care of rescued dogs; and

WHEREAS, the scope of work for project no. 10151, fund 435, is hereby set to include all supplies, construction, and required components necessary for the covered dog walk and remediation of the black mold discovered in the area of the dog kennels.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly hereby approves the following scope of work and amended budget.

SCOPE OF WORK

The funds in this project will provide for an outdoor covered dog walk area at the Animal Care Facility. The scope of work is hereby set to include all supplies, construction, equipment, and required components necessary for constructing the outdoor covered dog walk area and for remediation of the black mold discovered in the area of the dog kennels.
