AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY REAPPROPRIATING \$440,681 FROM 2018 NOVEMBER COOK INLET EARTHQUAKE - BOROUGH INFRASTRUCTURE, FUND 445, PROJECT NO. 55027, \$107,700 FROM BRIDGE & RAILROAD CROSSING MAJOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR, FUND 410, PROJECT NO. 35000, AND \$100,000 FROM THE GREATER WILLOW ROAD SERVICE AREA CAPITAL PROJECT FUND, FUND 410, PROJECT NO. 30042, TO SHIRLEY TOWNE BRIDGE RECONSTRUCTION, FUND 430, PROJECT NO. 35469.

WHEREAS, the intent and rationale of this ordinance are in the accompanying Informational Memorandum No. 20-137.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This Ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and Reappropriation Source. The Assembly does hereby reappropriate \$440,681 from 2018 November Cook Inlet Earthquake - Borough Infrastructure, fund 445, project no. 55027, \$107,700 from Bridge & Railroad Crossing Major Maintenance and Repair, fund 410, project no. 35000, and \$100,000 from the Greater Willow Road Service Area Capital project no. 30042, to Shirley Towne Bridge Reconstruction, fund 430, project no. 35469.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
