SUMMARY STATEMENT: The Shirley Towne Road Bridge across Willow Creek sustained significant damage to the north abutment during the 2012 flood. Creek water flow is continuing to erode that unprotected area of the bank. Funding is needed to repair and protect the bridge to allow for a secondary access into the residential subdivisions and other lands on the north side of the creek in the event the main access becomes impassable as it did during the winter of 2019-20.
