SUMMARY STATEMENT: On November 30, 2018, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough sustained damage to Houston Middle School due to a magnitude 7.0 earthquake. On February 19, 2020 the School Board approved Resolution 20-010 to contribute \$5,900,000 to the Houston Middle School reconstruction and repair project.

A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH SCHOOL BOARD IN SUPPORT OF THE HOUSTON MIDDLE SCHOOL RETROFIT

WHEREAS, on November 30, 2018, Houston Middle School received substantial damage during a 7.1 magnitude earthquake leaving the school unsafe to occupy; and

WHEREAS, the Mat-Su Borough School District passed Resolution 20-004 on October 2, 2019 supporting the replacement of the Houston academic wing and repair of the administrative wing and gymnasium at a project cost of \$28.9 million; and

WHEREAS, the Mat-Su Borough School District pays \$1.8 million annually to insure school facilities; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the District's portion of the shared insurance policy, approximately \$15 million of insurance proceeds are available to offset the cost of repairing the facility; and

WHEREAS, the Mat-Su Borough has identified \$8 million in set asides to fund the project; and

WHEREAS, the Mat-Su Borough is requesting a transfer of funds from the Mat-Su Borough School District to ensure all funds have been sequestered prior to awarding the construction contract; and

WHEREAS, Alaska State Statute 14.14.060 states the Borough Assembly through the Borough Administrator, shall provide for all major rehabilitation, all construction and major repair of school buildings; and

WHEREAS, it is a priority of the Mat-Su School Board to re-open the Houston facility for the purpose of educating our students.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mat-Su School Board supports the use of available fund balance, not to exceed \$5.9 million, to ensure the Houston Middle School Retrofit project is completed; and

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mat-Su School Board will transfer this money once the construction cost is complete or no later than June 30, 2020; and

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mat-Su School Board requests that upon funding approval from FEMA or the State of Alaska funds will be returned to the Mat-Su Borough School District within 30 calendar days so the money may be available for the general operations of the school district as was its intended purpose.
