A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING THE SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET FOR A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$754,435 FROM THE ALASKA STATE DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AND VETERANS AFFAIRS, DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, PUBLIC ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM FOR REPAIRS TO PORTIONS OF EARTHQUAKE DAMAGED INFRASTRUCTURE.
