A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AMENDING THE COVID-19 SMALL BUSINESS AND NONPROFIT RELIEF GRANT PROGRAM BY MODIFYING THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS TO SPECIFY THAT THE BUSINESS LICENSE MUST BE CURRENT BEFORE A GRANT AWARD IS MADE, ANY BUSINESS THAT APPLIES FOR A GRANT MUST HAVE PAID THE BUSINESS LICENSE FEE FOR 2019.

WHEREAS, the intent and rationale for this resolution are found in Informational Memorandum accompanying this resolution; and

WHEREAS, this resolution modifies the scope of work as set by Resolution Serial No. 20-070 and Informational Memorandum No. 20-140.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the eligibility requirements for the Matanuska-Susitna Borough COVID-19 Small Business & Nonprofit Relief Grant Program is amended to remove the eligibility requirement of "Business that do not have a current state of Mat-Su Borough business license as of January 1, 2020" and replace it with "Business that do not have a current state or Mat-Su Borough business license before a grant award is made, any business that applies for a grant must have paid the business license fee for 2019."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the maximum amount of the grant award is increase to \$25,000 and applies retroactively to the original date of the grant program.


