## MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 20-103

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING AN APPROPRIATION OF \$591,290 FROM THE AREAWIDE FUND BALANCE, FUND 100.272.000, TO FUND 410, PROJECT NO. 35000, FOR BRIDGE AND RAILROAD CROSSING MAJOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR AND THE DUST CONTROL PROGRAM (50 PERCENT ROAD SERVICE AREA CONSTRUCTION AND 50 PERCENT DUST CONTROL).

WHEREAS, MSB 3.24.030, sets forth the method by which vehicle taxes are allocated to the areawide fund, nonareawide fund, service areas, and the cities within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with MSB 3.24.030(C), any remaining funds are to be allocated to the bridge and railroad crossing major maintenance and repair and dust control matching grant program (50 percent road service area and 50 percent dust control); and

WHEREAS, for fiscal year 2020, it was estimated that the remaining funds would be \$250,000 and that amount was appropriated to the program; and

WHEREAS, all vehicle tax payments have been received for fiscal year 2020, and it has been determined that the amount actually available for the program was \$841,290; and

WHEREAS, the additional amount, \$591,291 was credited to the areawide fund balance at June 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the additional \$591,291 must now be appropriated from the areawide fund balance for the bridge and railroad

crossing major maintenance and repair and dust control matching grant program (50 percent road service area and 50 percent dust control.

## BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and Appropriation source. There is hereby appropriated by the Assembly \$591,291 from the areawide fund balance, fund 100.272.00, to the road projects fund, fund 410, project no. 35000 for bridge and railroad crossing major maintenance and repair and dust control matching grant program (50 percent road service area and 50 percent dust control).

Section 3. <u>Effective date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
