**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 21-003**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING AN APPROPRIATION OF \$1,500,000 FROM THE CENTRAL MAT-SU FIRE SERVICE AREA FUND BALANCE, FUND 250, TO PROJECT NO. 45066, FUND 405, TO PURCHASE AN AERIAL PLATFORM AND RELATED EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, Replacing Truck 6-2 with a new 100' Aerial Platform will allow Central the ability to reach areas the current 75' ladder truck can't reach and give us more capabilities; and

WHEREAS, the West Lakes Fire Service Area is in need of a long term replacement for one of their current aerial trucks as both of their current aerial trucks have failed testing; and

WHEREAS, Central's current 75' Aerial Ladder Truck (currently Truck 6-2) is in excellent condition and will be a perfect fit for, and will be sold to, the West Lakes Fire Service Area; and

WHEREAS, the new aerial platform truck for Central will be placed at Station 6-1 with the current Truck 6-1 being moved to Station 6-2 giving Central Mat-Su two aerial platforms, one at Station 6-1 and one at Station 5-1, to cover the core area around Wasilla and the hospital and the 107' ladder truck to cover the Kink Goose Bay area; and

WHEREAS, the Central Mat-Su Fire Chief and Fire Service Area Board of Supervisors approves of this aerial platform and equipment purchase; and

WHEREAS, the approved scope of work and budget is contained in Resolution Serial No. 21-002.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Appropriation Source. The Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby approves an appropriation of \$1,500,000 to Project No. 45066, from the Central Mat-Su Fire Service Area Fund Balance, Fund 250, to purchase an aerial platform and related equipment.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
