RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 21-005**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING THE SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET FOR DISASTER RELIEF FUNDS FROM THE 2018 COOK INLET EARTHQUAKE DISASTER FOR WASILLA AREA SCHOOLS AND BOROUGH ROADS AND BRIDGES.

WHEREAS, on November 30, 2018 the Matanuska-Susitna Borough sustained severe damages to Borough roads, schools, public facilities and infrastructure due to a magnitude 7.0 earthquake; and

WHEREAS, a local, state and federal disaster declaration was issued; and

WHEREAS, costs incurred during the disaster were determined to be eligible for state (25%) and federal (75%) funding assistance; and

WHEREAS, the borough was awarded \$67,454.00 for repairs to borough roads and bridges and \$80,271.57 for repairs to Wasilla area schools.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby approves the scope of work and budget for the 2018 Cook Inlet Earthquake, project no. 55026 and 55027, fund 445.

SCOPE OF WORK

Emergency protective measures, emergency response, debris removal, replacement and/or repair of borough schools, roads, bridges, facilities, and infrastructure from damage caused by the 2018 Cook Inlet Earthquake.
