WHEREAS, during the 2008 State Legislative Session a bill was passed that would allow a portion of the fiscal year 2009 Community Revenue Sharing Program (now known as Community Assistance Program) funds to be passed through to a community council; and

WHEREAS, the program has been funded each year since it was established, most recently for fiscal year 2021; and

WHEREAS, 19 community councils are eligible for participation in the program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly hereby approves the scope of work and budget for the fiscal year 2021 Community Assistance Program, project no. 47033.

## SCOPE OF WORK

To provide grant funds in the amount of \$15,789 to each of the 19 community councils. Councils must be registered as an incorporated nonprofit entity with the State of Alaska and enter into an applicable agreement with the borough. The funds can only be spent for the public benefit of the unincorporated area. The nineteen community councils are as follows:
