MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 20-112

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS OF \$375,792 FROM THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AND VETERANS AFFAIRS FOR EMERGENCY FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION ROAD REPAIRS CAUSED BY THE 2018 COOK INLET EARTHQUAKE DISASTER, PROJECT NO. 55027.

WHEREAS, following the November 2018 Cook Inlet Earthquake, the borough completed necessary emergency repairs to four roads that were designated as Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) roads; and

WHEREAS, these repairs, in the amount of \$375,792, have been determined to be eligible for reimbursement from the Alaska State Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, Division of Homeland Security.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and Appropriation Source. The Assembly hereby approves the acceptance and appropriation of state grant funds in the amount of \$375,792, to fund 445, project no. 55027 for emergency road repairs caused by the 2018 earthquake disaster.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
