SUMMARY STATEMENT: On November 12, 2020, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Purchasing Division issued a solicitation requesting bids from qualified contractors to construct upgrades to the Shirley Towne Road Bridge, which crosses Willow Creek in Willow, Alaska. The bridge sustained damage during a major flood in 2012. During the flood event, the main channel of the creek shifted northward and destroyed the north abutment, and is actively eroding the remaining northern approach road. The bridge improvements are needed to extend and repair the bridge, so that an emergency access route is available across the creek in the event that the Michelle

Drive Bridge further downstream becomes impassible.

Construction Services purchased will support the Public Works Department in assembly district #7.

In response to the advertisement, ten bids were received. Award recommendation is being made to Roger Hickel Contracting, Inc. as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder based on the sum of base bid & alternate bid 1.

The substantial completion date for this project is March 31, 2021 with the final completion of June 30, 2021.

In accordance with MSB 3.08.170(B), Administration requests authority to modify the resulting contract completion date by 30 days for unforeseen circumstances.

The Public Works Department, Pre-Design & Engineering Division will be administering the contract with the aid of PND Engineers, Inc. who will be performing construction management services.

Shirley Towne Bridge Repair SCOPE OF WORK

Project Background and Scope

The Matanuska-Susitna Borough (MSB) is soliciting bids from qualified contractors to construct upgrades to the Shirley Towne Road Bridge, which crosses Willow Creek in Willow, Alaska, that sustained damage during a major flood in 2012. During the flood event, the main channel of the creek shifted northward and destroyed the north abutment, and is actively eroding the remaining northern approach road. The bridge improvements are needed to extend and repair the bridge, so that an emergency access route is available across the creek in the event that the Michelle Drive Bridge further downstream becomes impassible. Environmental permits will be obtained by the Borough for this project, including those in attachment 1, unless otherwise specified in the project documents. The geotechnical report for this project is included in attachment 2, and is to be used for information only.

All construction shall be completed in accordance with the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) Standard Specifications for Highway Construction (SSHC) 2020 Edition. Project specific special provisions are provided in the following sections. The requirements contained in these specifications and special provisions are hereby made a part of this solicitation and resultant contract.

The project area begins on Shirley Towne Road approximately ¼-mile north of the Willow-Fishhook Road in Willow, Alaska. The bridge is not usable and work will require access to both sides of the creek. For work on the south side, access is from Shirley Towne Road via Willow-Fishhook Road. For access to the north side, access is via Deneki Drive, then Michelle Drive, Kelley Circle and Kenny Blvd. See project location and vicinity maps in attachment 3.

Work Description

- Supply labor, equipment, materials and supplies to perform the required work as shown on construction plans for MSB project number 35469.
- All work shall be substantially complete prior to March 31, 2021. Final Completion shall be obtained by June 30, 2021.
- Contractor will be required to obtain an ADEC APDES permit prior to earthwork activities.
- Contractor shall request locates from the utilities having facilities in the area. Use the Alaska Digline, Inc. Locate Call Center for the utilities. See Section 105-1.06 for digline number and a list of utility companies in the area.
- Contractor shall apply for a Traffic Control Permit from the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Permit Center prior to commencing work on the roads and bridges, and the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities prior to beginning any work affecting traffic on Willow-Fishhook Road.
- The estimated project construction cost is approximately \$500,000.

Bid Form

- Base bid Line Item 1 shall include all materials and labor required for the addition of a new single-lane span at the north end of Bridge 1831 and all items listed in the project specifications for the base bid of the new bridge span.
- Base bid Line item 2 shall include the cost of labor to re-install bridge deck and bridge rail materials for two
 existing 80-spans of bridge. Owner furnished materials are stockpiled in Willow, Alaska.
- Base bid Line items 3 and 4 shall include costs to furnish additional materials for contingencies in decking the
 existing bridge.
- Alternate bid Line item 1 shall include, at a per foot basis, the cost to furnish, splice and drive additional piling beyond the tip elevation shown on the contract documents if needed.
