MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 21-011

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL DISASTER RELIEF FUNDS FOR COLONY HIGH SCHOOL OF \$49,728.09 FOR DAMAGES SUSTAINED DURING THE 2018 COOK INLET EARTHQUAKE, PROJECT NO. 55026.

WHEREAS, on November 30, 2018, the Borough sustained severe damages to roads, schools, public facilities, and infrastructure due to a magnitude 7.0 earthquake; and

WHEREAS, local, state, and federal disaster declarations were issued; and

WHEREAS, costs incurred during the disaster were determined to be eligible for state (25 percent) and federal (75 percent) funding assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Borough was awarded \$162,070.96 for repairs to damages at Colony High School; and

WHEREAS, additional costs have been identified and approved for reimbursement in the amount of \$49,728.09 for Colony High School.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and Appropriation Source. The Assembly hereby approves the acceptance and appropriation of federal and state grant funds in the amount of \$49,728.09 to fund 445, project no. 55026, for expenses to Colony High School caused from the 2018 earthquake disaster.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
