A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING THE SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET FOR THE PURCHASE OF A WASTE CONTAINER ROLL-OFF TRAILER PUP.

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WHEREAS, the purchase of a waste container roll-off trailer pup is required to meet the increased demands of hauling waste from Borough transfer stations to the Central Landfill; and

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Division obtained a quote to include freight for a TT-OR-176 Pup through Sourcewell cooperative purchasing program (formerly National Joint Powers Alliance) totaling \$62,421; and

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Division identified \$76,291 in leftover Capital Projects funds from completed or cancelled projects; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance Serial No. 20-101 authorized the reappropriation of \$65,542.05 from project no. 25020-2402 and 25035-2407, to project no. 25001 for the purchase of a waste container roll-off trailer pup to include freight and a 5 percent contingency for any unforeseen rate changes to shipping

and/or manufacturing costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Assembly approves the scope of work and budget for project no. 25001, fund 420, to allow for the purchase of a waste container roll-off trailer pup.

#### SCOPE OF WORK

Purchase a waste container roll-off trailer pup meeting the specifications listed in the quote from Sourcewell.
