**SUMMARY STATEMENT:** In accordance with code, the District delivered the preliminary budget to the Assembly on March 30, 2021.

The total school district budget request is \$261,418,559. Of that amount, they have made the request that \$65,841,806 be provided by the Borough. Resolution Serial No. 21-037 will establish the minimum amount of money from local sources to be made available for school purposes. That amount is \$34,548,940, which is the required Borough (local) contribution. This minimum required local

contribution amount (\$34,548,940) is calculated in accordance with AS 14.17.410(b)(2) based upon the full and true value of property in the borough, as determined by the Department of Commerce, Community & Economic Development as of January 1, 2020. The required contribution is calculated as follows.

## Required Local Contribution Computation (AS 14.17.410(b)(2))

2.65 mills equivalent: Required Contribution

\$34,548,940

Passage of Resolution Serial No. 21-037 fulfills the requirements of AS 14.14.060(c) and MSB 3.04.020(B). Additionally, Resolution Serial No. 21-037 provides a mechanism for increasing local support for school purposes once the full status of state funding of local governments is determined. The purpose of Resolution No. 21-037 is not to restrict the amount of "local support" for school operations, but to provide the assembly with a degree of flexibility. Much of the information necessary for an informed decision on the budget is still unknown at the time this resolution was prepared.

The Borough assembly provided \$62,310,148 in local support for education in fiscal year 2021. In addition, \$22,863,408 was provided for net debt service for the school construction and improvement bonds. This funding equated to 8.62 mills for local support of education.
