MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 21-033

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING AND ADDITIONAL \$100,000 FROM THE ALASKA STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES TO FUND 480, PROJECT NO. 47038 REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION ORGANIZATION FOR THE PERFORMANCE OF PRE-METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION PLANNING EFFORTS.

WHEREAS, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough has received an amendment to Addendum A & B of the Memorandum of Agreement between the Alaska State Department of Transportation and Public Facilities and the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the objective of the amendment is to continue to conduct pre-Metropolitan Planning Organization planning activities and formulate recommendations and proposals to present to the Governor and a future Metropolitan Planning Organization Memorandum of Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska State Department of Transportation and Public Facilities and the Borough share a mutual desire to ensure that future Federal requirements for a new Memorandum of Agreement are met as expeditiously and efficiently as possible, to ensure increased mobility, improved accessibility, and safer freight and passenger transport within any current or future Urbanized Area(s)

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities supports this action by the Borough and has set aside an additional \$100,000 of Federal transportation planning funds in Federal fiscal year 2021 to assist with these efforts; and

WHEREAS, project no. 47038 Regional Transportation Organization has a balance of \$95,098.98 and it is the Borough's intent to use \$9,030 of this funding to meet the required 9.03 percent match requirement.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and Appropriation Source. The Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly does hereby authorize the acceptance and appropriation of an additional \$100,000 from the Alaska State Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to fund 480, project no. 47038.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
