SUMMARY STATEMENT: The Matanuska Telephone Association has requested the Matanuska-Susitna Borough's assistance in applying for a Broadband Infrastructure Program grant from the United States Department of Commerce National Telecommunications and Informational Administration. The application must be submitted through Grants.gov in partnership with a local government in August 2021. Any required match will be provided by the Matanuska Telephone Association.
