A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING THE SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET FOR THE SETTLERS BAY COASTAL PARK, PROJECT NO. 15040, FUND 440, FOR CONTINUED PARK DEVELOPMENT.

WHEREAS, the Borough has an adopted a Recreation Development Plan for the Settlers Bay Coastal Park that outlines the park development needs; and

WHEREAS, the continued development of the park will help to increase user access to the park by completing the construction of the American's with Disabilities Act (ADA) Bluff Trail, the opening of two new concrete restrooms, and building additional trails; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance Serial No. 21-050 accepted and appropriated a \$20,980 grant from the Mat-Su Trails and Parks Foundation, to the Settlers Bay Coastal Park project no. 15040, fund 440, for continued development of the park; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires the Borough to provide a match of \$10,490; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Department will provide an \$8,000 cash match from project no. 15040-4200-4203, fund 440; and

WHEREAS, in-kind match will also be provided by the Borough, which includes the donation of large boulders to be used as traffic control and staff labor costs from Land and Resources Management staff and the Borough Trail Crew.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly hereby approves the following scope of work and budget for development of the Settlers Bay Coastal Park.
