A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AMENDING THE SCOPES OF WORK AND BUDGETS FOR PROJECT NO. 10063, DOROTHY SWANDA JONES ADMINISTRATION BUILDING ANNEX; PROJECT NO. 30114, FISH PASSAGE IMPROVEMENTS; PROJECT NO. 47500, MAINTENANCE SHOP EQUIPMENT/UPGRADE; AND THE MATANUSKA RIVER EROSION DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROJECT, PROJECT NO. 47018.

WHEREAS, the intent and rational for this resolution can be found in the accompanying Informational Memorandum No. 21-120.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly approves the following amended scopes of work and budgets:

AMENDED SCOPE OF WORK

Amend the scopes of work for the Dorothy Swanda Jones Administration Building Annex project, project no. 10063; the Fish Passage Improvements project, project no. 30114; the Maintenance Shop Equipment project, project no. 47500; and the new Matanuska River Erosion Dispute Resolution project, project no. 47108, to prepare property near the Matanuska River for purchase from the private owners and transfer it to the Alaska State Department of Transportation and Public Facilities with the intent that the property will become part of the Glenn Highway right of way.
