A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AMENDING THE SCOPE OF WORK FOR FISCAL YEARS 2011 THROUGH 2017 COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM, TO ALLOW LAZY MOUNTAIN COMMUNITY COUNCIL TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO THREE LOCAL NONPROFITS THAT PROVIDE PUBLIC BENEFIT TO THE LAZY MOUNTAIN COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS, the intent and rationale for this resolution are found in the accompanying Informational Memorandum No. 21-148.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly hereby amends the scope of work for a portion of fiscal years 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, and 2017 Community Assistance Program; and authorizes the Borough Manager to enter into a memorandum of agreement with non-profit agencies for the public benefit of the Lazy Mountain Community.

**AMENDED SCOPE OF WORK**

Lazy Mountain Community Council funding provided for the public benefit to Palmer Volunteer Fire Association for an emergency off-road vehicle, The YAK for operating expenses for the teen center, and to The Mat-Su Trails and Parks Foundation for an electric gate at the Lazy Mountain Trailhead parking lot.
