MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 21-064

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL RELIEF MONIES OF \$271,375.20 FOR THE SEPTEMBER 2012 SOUTHCENTRAL FLOOD DISASTER.

WHEREAS, in September of 2012, due to heavy rains in the area, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough sustained Boroughwide flood damages; and

WHEREAS, a local, state, and federal declaration was made, and costs incurred are eligible for state and federal funding assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Yoder Revetment project is complete and the grant agency has issued a time extension and cost adjustment amendment (adding \$81,503), as required in preparation of project closure; and

WHEREAS, a time extension and cost adjustment amendment adding \$189,872.20 is also needed for the alternate project designated to replace a railroad crossing on Mike Ardaw Road near Willow; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly must accept and appropriate the additional grant funds, and approve the amended budget.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. <u>Acceptance and Appropriation Source</u>. The Assembly does hereby authorize the acceptance and appropriation of the September 2012 Southcentral Flood disaster relief monies in the amount of \$271,375.20 from the Alaska State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management and the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
