A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR THE SEPTEMBER 2012 SOUTHCENTRAL FLOOD DISASTER RELIEF MONIES.

WHEREAS, in September of 2012, due to heavy rains in the area, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough sustained borough-wide flood damages; and

WHEREAS, a local, state, and federal disaster was declared and costs incurred have been determined as eligible for state Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency funding assistance; and

WHEREAS, to date, the Borough has been awarded \$4,749,581.97 of disaster relief funds for the 2012 flood event; and

WHEREAS, amendments have been received for a cost adjustment of \$81,503 for the Yoder Revetment project and \$189,872.20 for the replacement railroad crossing in Willow; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly must accept and appropriate the grant funds and approve the amended budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly hereby approves the following amended budget for the September 2012

Southcentral Flood disaster relief monies, project no. 55017,  
fund 445.
