SUMMARY STATEMENT: The purpose of this legislation is to inform the Assembly that the Borough Manager will be asked to sign a Maintenance and Operations Memorandum of Agreement between the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF) and the Matanuska-Susitna Borough (Borough) for the Hermon Road Upgrade and Extension project.
