




**SUMMARY STATEMENT:** The purpose of this legislation is to inform the Assembly that the Borough Manager will be asked to sign a Maintenance and Operations Memorandum of Agreement between the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF) and the Matanuska-Susitna Borough (Borough) for the Hermon Road Upgrade and Extension project.

The Public Works staff submitted nominations to the State of Alaska CTP. The Hermon Road Upgrade and Extension was one of four projects awarded funding contingent on the fulfillment of several conditions including the requirement that ADOT&PF plan, design,

and construct the federal-aid projects.

Another condition for this funding is that all constructed improvements be owned and maintained by the Borough.

The Borough and ADOT&PF have developed the maintenance and operations agreement for Hermon Road Upgrade and Extension and it will be presented to the Borough Manager for signature.
