Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

The Assembly does hereby authorize the acceptance and appropriation of federal and state grant funds in the amount of \$1,235,753.84 to fund 445, project no. 55026, for expenses related to the 2018 earthquake disaster for Houston Middle School temporary relocation.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
