A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY SUPPORTING THE CURRY RIDGE RIDERS APPLICATION FOR A RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM GRANT THROUGH THE ALASKA STATE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES.

WHEREAS, the Curry Ridge Riders are seeking grant funds through the Recreation Trails Program, offered by the Alaska State Department of Natural Resources; and

WHEREAS, a stipulation of the grant application is for a resolution of support from the Assembly recognizing the Curry Ridge Riders as an entity that manages the South Denali winter trails; and

WHEREAS, the Curry Ridge Riders have a Trail Care Agreement with the Borough; and

WHEREAS, through the Trail Care Agreement, the Curry Ridge Riders have adopted the segments of the Chulitna Bluff Trail, East-West Express Trail, and the Trapper Creek/Rabideux Creek Winter Trail located on Borough managed lands; and

WHEREAS, this agreement gives the Curry Ridge Riders permission to place and maintain adequate signage, control vegetation within the trail corridor, and maintain the trail surface for safe and enjoyable travel on the adopted trails; and

WHEREAS, the agreement was signed in October of 2020 and is valid for three years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Assembly supports the Curry Ridge Riders application for a Recreational Trails Program Grant issued through the Alaska State Department of Natural Resources.
