SUMMARY STATEMENT: This resolution is in support of the Curry Ridge Riders application for a Recreational Trails Program grant through the State of Alaska, Department of Natural Resources. The Curry Ridge Riders are seeking grant funds through the Recreation Trails Program, offered by the State of Alaska, Department of Natural Resources. A stipulation of the grant application is for a resolution of support from the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly recognizing the Curry Ridge Riders as an entity that manages the South Denali winter trials

The Curry Ridge Riders have a Trail Care Agreement with the Borough, adopting the segments of the Chulitna Bluff Trail, East-West Express Trail, and the Trapper Creek/Rabideux Creek Winter Trail located on Matanuska-Susitna Borough managed lands. This agreement gives the Curry Ridge Riders permission to place and maintain adequate signage, control vegetation within the trail corridor, and maintain the trail surface for safe and enjoyable

travel on the adopted trails. The agreement was signed in October of 2020, and is valid for three years.
