A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING THE SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET FOR THE COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH 19 UNINCORPORATED COMMUNITIES WITHIN THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, the intent and rationale for this resolution are found in the accompanying Informational Memorandum No. 21-182, and Ordinance Serial No. 21-093.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly hereby approves the scope of work and budget for the fiscal year 2022 Community Assistance Program, project no. 47033, and authorizes the Manager to enter into grant agreements as follows:

SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET

Provide funds in the amount of \$15,789 to each of the 19 community councils, list below, or their specified nonprofit entity. Each council or specified entity must be a registered nonprofit in good standing with the State of Alaska, and enter into an agreement with the borough. The fund can only be spent for the public benefit of the unincorporated area.
